Books and equipment

- The school provides each child with the equipment and books that they need. Many parents wish to supplement this and buy their children their own pens, pencils, calculators. Please check with your child's class teacher to see what is suitable for the classroom.
- Parents of pupils who lose or damage library books, and who have signed a consent for m for their child to take the book home, are expected to pay the cost of replacement or repair

Activities within the school day:

Any payment from parents for these activities is voluntary but if parents are unable
or unwilling to contribute, it may be that the activity will not be able to take place.
 Pupils will never be treated differently whether or not their parents have made any
such payments

Activities outside the school day:

For these activities payment is required for pupils to take part.

Residential Visits

 Payment will be required in respect of residential visits taking place in and outside school time.

Music Tuition

• The Head Teacher is authorised to charge for music tuition outside normal classroom activities, when permitted

Loss and Damage to School Property

 Parents of a pupil who damages or loses any item of school property or equipment, including, for example, windows or computer software, are liable for the cost of repair or replacement
