

RE

The children will develop their knowledge of the Creation, learn about Hindism, Revelation, Prayer, Feasts and Saints, Advent and Christmas.

English

The children will be writing newspaper reports, Diary writing, Instructions, Myths and Legends, Performance poetry and Story writing.

PE

During their PE sessions the children will develop skills needed for tag rugby, football and dance.

Maths

During this term the children will start to learn about the different aspects of Maths using the Singapore method of learning and following the Maths No Problem scheme of work. They will be learning Number and Place value, Addition, Subtraction, Multiplication and Division, Fractions and Decimals, Measurement, Geometry, Shapes and Position, Statistics, Ratio, Proportion and Algebra.

Invaders and Settlers - The Celts And the Romans

Science

The children will be learning about how animals and humans are connected and Forces and Magnets. Experimenting to see how things work and the changes you can make and the effects these changes have on their components.

art

During art the children will examine the intricacies of Celtic knots, and attempt to recreate them.

They will also look at 1960's psychedelia as part of the St. Mary's 50 years celebration.

Geography

The children will explore some of the aspects of the Geography of Europe.

History

Children will learn about The Ancient Celts and how they lived compared to how we live now. A trip to New Barn will 'bring to life' how people lived in Celtic times.

ICT

During ICT the children will learn Commanding in Programming, Research using the internet, Using a browser address as well as using the Education City programme.

DT

Alongside our Celts topic the children will look at the food we eat compared with the diet of the Celts and examine the nutrition in both diets. They will make bread, learning skills of kneading that the Celts may well have used themselves.
