#### Information below from DASP music:

Children within the DASP schools are invited to take part in the exciting 'Farewell Celebration for Dippy the Dinosaur' on Friday 4<sup>th</sup> May.

As you know Dippy has been resident at the Dorset County Museum since February as part of the national Dippy on Tour project. He will be leaving Dorchester in early May to move on to his next stop on the tour, in Birmingham.

The Dorset County Museum would like to invite the children of Dorchester to join them in a 'Farewell Celebration for Dippy', which will be centred around the singing of the *Dippy the Dinosaur* song, written by DASP Music Coordinator, Hanna Trevorrow. All children will need to be accompanied by an adult throughout the entire event (both at Brewery Square and at the museum). At Brewery Square, there is no limit to the numbers of audience that can watch the performance of the song. In the museum, due to space restrictions, each child will only be allowed to be accompanied by one adult.

The number of children who may take part is limited to 300 and is open to anyone in years 1-6. Places will be allocated on a first come, first served basis and registration is required by this Monday coming.

It is very important that all children who take part, know the song really well off-by-heart (there is likely to be close-up video footage). They will need to copy the actions on the Skylarks video which can be found on the song resource page.

At present, the details for the event are as follows, but please be warned that exact timings may change slightly:

Date: Friday 4<sup>th</sup> May

4pm-4.30pm: Meet at the fountains in Brewery Square (collect and put on T-shirts)

4.30pm: Sing the Dippy song at Brewery Square

4.40pm: Walk in procession from Brewery Square to the Dorset County Museum via South Street

5.15pm: 'Dippy farewell celebration' at the museum including singing of the Dippy song, speeches and refreshments for children

Approx. 6pm: Event ends
