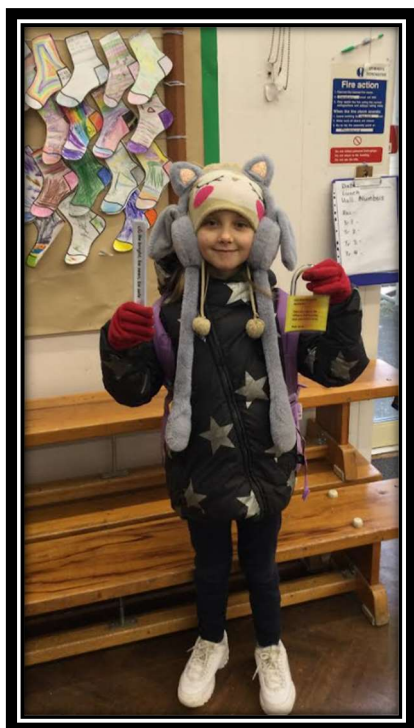

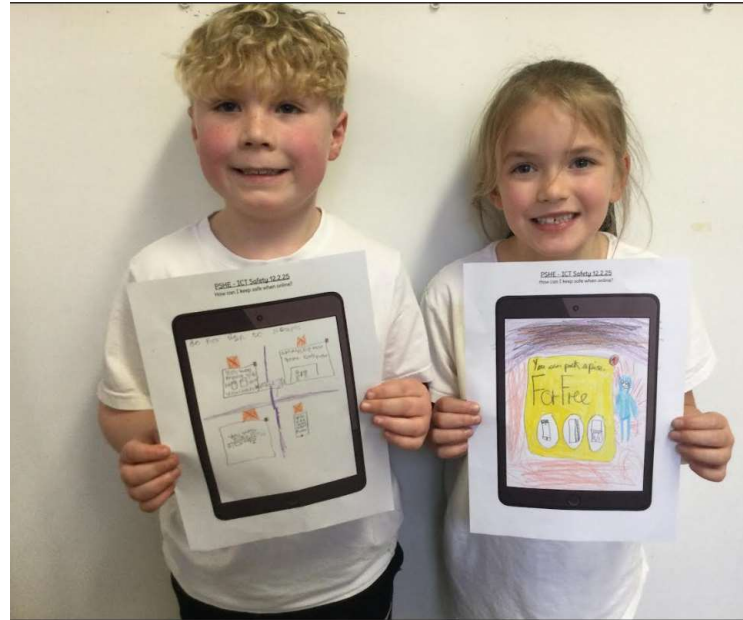
School in A Bag Assembly

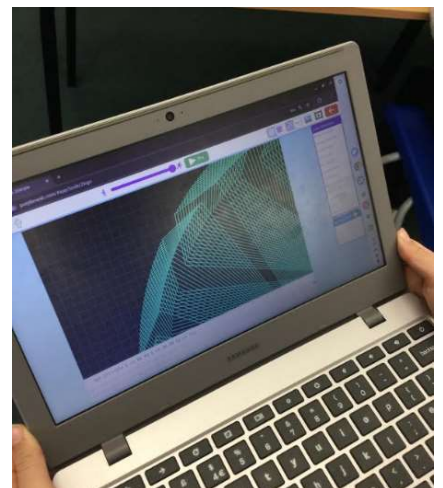
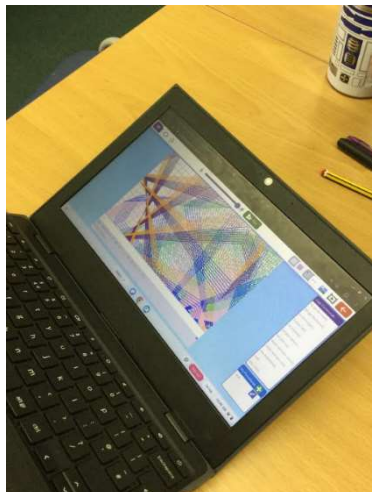
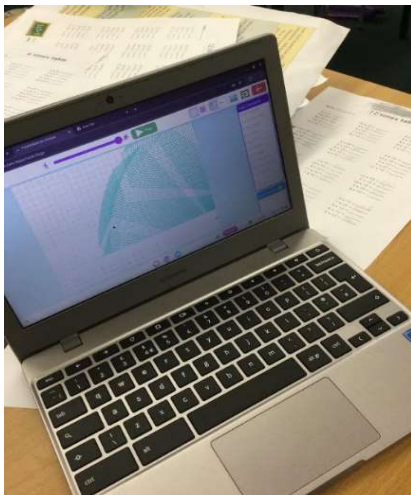


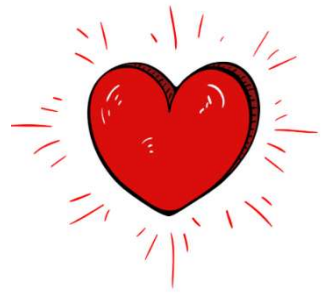
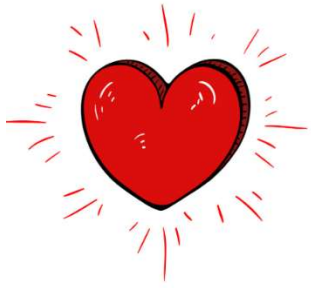
Well done Adriana on winning this week's Golden Padlock, Adriana was wrapped up nice and cozy for today's cycle into school.

We are looking forward to celebrating **World Book Day** on **Thursday 6th March**, which is in the second week of the next half term. Your child will have a day full of book related activities which I am sure they will enjoy.

As part of the day, we encourage your child to come into school dressed up as either a book character or as a word. If your child chooses the latter, it simply means that their costume represents the word that they have chosen. They can attach the word on the costume. For example, if the word is "scientist" they dress up as a Scientist, if it is "star" they wear a star on their top. We are very keen that parents do not feel the need to buy anything new for this day. Hopefully the word option means that all children will have a ready made costume that is easy to prepare.
