
Well done Adriana on winning this week's Golden Padlock, Adriana was wrapped up nice and cozy for today's cycle into school.

Anning class has been learning about internet safety this week and have created brilliant posters about being safe online.






Year 4-In ICT this week we have been learning to use Logo to program shapes and patterns.
