Some of our Iceni class took part in a football match last Friday at Broadmayne School, they all worked together really well. Noemis was player of the match - she played amazing!



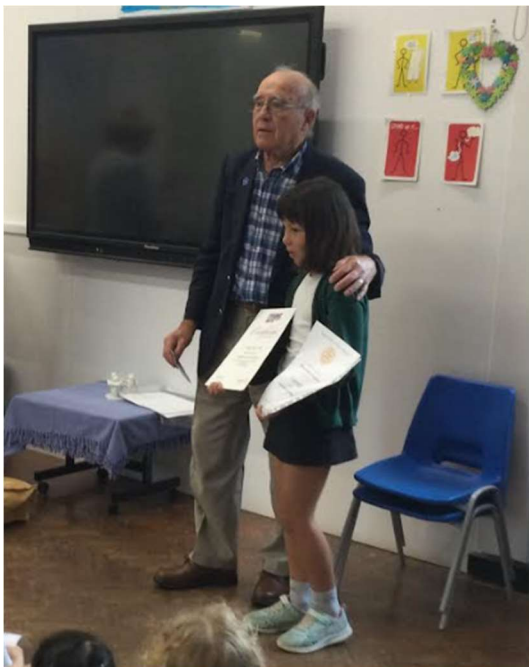
