We are looking for Parent Governor's, if you are interested in becoming a Governor please do pop into the office for an application form.

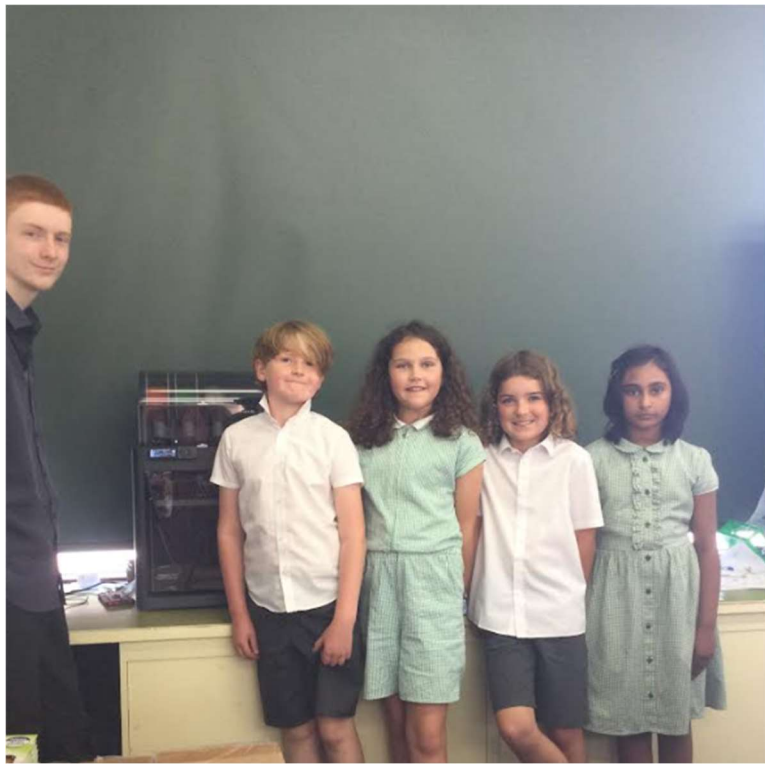
