The children had the opportunity to learn about the important work the council does for Dorchester, and how they, too, can make a difference through their own School Council.
















School Grounds Day - 18.10.25

We are incredibly grateful to our fantastic families who gave up their Saturday and worked so hard to make our school look wonderful. Thank you.
























Work for us
