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









Cello Scholarship Opportunity - Year 3 & 4 parents

Due to a kind benefactor, DASP are excited to be able to offer a scholarship for one child in Year 3 or 4 across several DASP schools, to be funded to start cello lessons from January onwards.

The scholarship will completely cover the cost of about seventeen 20 minute individual lessons through DASP Music from January onwards (lessons are usually £11.50 per lesson). In addition, the child will be able to borrow a cello free-of-charge. If the child is progressing well, there is the potential that the scholarship could be reapplied for in future years.

If you would like to apply for your child to receive this cello scholarship, please submit two letters; one from yourself and one from your child. The letters should detail why your child would like to learn the cello, what you hope/they hope they will benefit from by learning the cello, how you will support them at home and what you will do/they will do to ensure that they make the most of this opportunity.
