





Kingston Class: Summer 1 2022: Me And My Family

Key Vocabulary

Mother, Father, brother, sister, grandparents, relatives, family.

Key Knowledge

Children will begin to make sense of their own life-story and family's history. They will be able to say who is in their family and describe their relationships to themselves. Children will know that some of their family members share their home but other family members live in their own homes.

Home Learning

Talk to your child about who makes up your immediate and extended family. Use photos to explain/remind children who people are. Due to lockdown restrictions children will have had fewer opportunities to see members of their family who don't share their home. Talk to your child about family names and relationships; for example there are many different names used for grandparents and this can sometimes be a bit confusing when children are talking to people outside the family. "This is Nana she is your grandma, she is Daddy's mummy." The idea of parents having their own parents and siblings can sometimes be tricky to grasp!
