







# Music Activities – Key Stage 2

Your challenge is to find out about the traditional music of that place and listen to a piece of music.</p> 
<p><b>Writing Lyrics</b></p> <p>Write a set of lyrics that reflect a mood or tell a story.</p> <p>Remember to keep the chorus simple, catchy and repetitive. Use the verses for storytelling.</p> 	<p><b>Singing Club</b></p> <p>Join in and sing a different song everyday with soprano singer Elin Manahan Thomas.</p> <p><i>Find @elin_manahan or follow the link from @musicalstmarys Twitter page</i></p>	<p><b>Singing Club 2</b></p> <p>Practice some of your favourite worship songs such as 'I am the Earth' and 'Here I am to Worship'. Look them up on YouTube and sing along.</p> <p>#singingmakesyouhappy!</p>	<p><b>Karaoke Time!</b></p> <p>Type in the name of your favourite song with the word 'karaoke' on the end.
