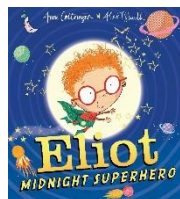

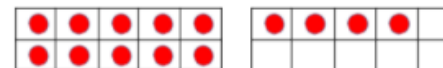

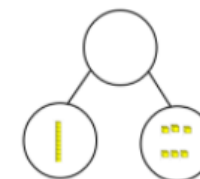

In what ways do special people in our parish help us?

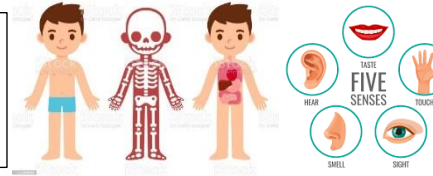


SCIENCE

Special words: body, body parts, bones, health, senses, sight, hearing, smell, touch and taste

FOREST SCHOOL

Special words: worms, soil, saddle, segments

Try making a wormery out of an old plastic bottle.

ICT

Special words: log on, algorithm, program, direction, arrows, up, down, left & right.
