#### ₋iteracy

Over the course of the term we will study a selection of narrative and non-narrative writing. We will be following the Write Stuff approach in our learning, focusing on creating sentences with a variety of grammar and word choices. This half term term we looking at writing instructions.

#### Maths

During this term we will look at Fractions and telling the time.

In Fractions, we will be comparing fractions, identifying equivalent fractions and adding and subtracting fractions.

In Time, we will be estimating time, counting in seconds and telling the time to the nearest 5 minutes and to the nearest minute.

#### Science

This half term we are learning about plants. We will identify parts of a plant, understand how they transport water from the roots to the leaves and how they make their own food through photosynthesis.

# Summer Term

# Tennis and Kick Rounders
