

## YEAR THREE– ART– SUMMER—3D: TELLING STORIES THROUGH DRAWING AND MAKING

### Key Questions:

How are artists inspired by other art forms?  
How can I use exaggeration as a tool to convey the intention of my drawing?  
How can I respond to literature/poetry in the form of sculpture?

### Key words:

Sculpture, Armature, Structure, Cover, Modroc, Clay, Construct, Model, Character, Personality.

### Activity:

Try creating 3D models from different media. What can you find around your home? What would be the best material for your model? An old sock? Some junk from the recycling bin? Some home made salt dough? Try different media to make the same model.

### What will I learn; skills and techniques

I will see how artists are inspired by other artists often working in other art forms.

I will make a sculpture using materials to model or construct which is inspired by a character in a book or film.

I will reflect and share how the way I made my sculpture helps capture my feelings about the original character.
