### **Year 4 Music Concert – Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> March 2017**

Year 4 children are taking part in the DASP Choral Festival with other first schools from DASP on Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> March. They will be going to St Osmund's Middle School in Dorchester for the morning, to rehearse for the performance held in the evening for parents. They will be leaving school at 9.30 am and returning to school by 12 noon in time for lunch at St Mary's.



For the evening, the children need to be at St Osmund's Middle School Sports Hall in Dorchester at 6.00 pm (the doors to the performance space will not open before 6.00 pm). The performance will then start at 6.30 pm and will last around 1 hour.

Due to the high number of students involved, we ask that each child brings a maximum of 2 adults with them to watch the performance, in order that everyone can be seated in the hall.



Entrance to the performance is free. There will be a retiring collection to raise funds for DASP Music (registered charity 1162919). This money is then used by the DASP schools for musical projects such as this in the future.

**For the evening, children will need to wear their school uniform.**
