- I can evaluate my slider - does my character move along smoothly?

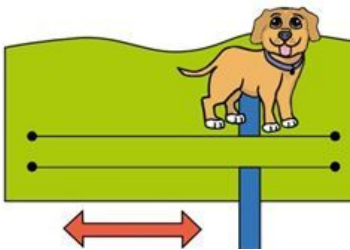

Slider, background, character, materials, measure, mark, cut, join, assemble, move, slide, gingerbread man, smooth.

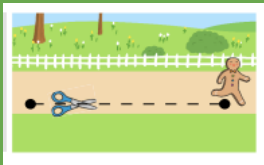
Design:

- Is there a better way of cutting the paper to make the character move smoothly?

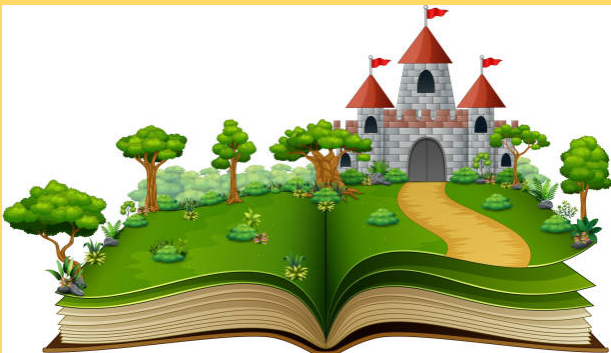
