Communication and Language

Our topic this half term gives the children a lot of opportunity to learn new vocabulary, ask questions and explain their own knowledge. The children will be undertaking a project for their home learning and will be sharing that information with their friends.

We will also continue our Talk for Writing with some focus stories linked to our topic that the children will learn. Our first story will be How to Catch a Star. Once we have learnt the story we will then make changes to create our own!

PSHF

In our SCARF/SEAL groups we will be developing our ability to listen to each other, respect another person's choice or differences and to problem solve in a good way. We will be finding out about how to keep healthy and make healthy choices in addition to helping Harold the Giraffe make good choices.

Forest School

In Forest School we will be learning about our boundaries and to respect our log circle. Once this is in place we will begin having fires and cooking outside. We will be learning about the different trees that grow on our site and how the seasons change them. We will look at how we can care for wildlife in Winter such as making bird feeders and hedgehog houses. In Forest School we also have some time to explore, climbing trees, digging in the mud and rolling down the mound.


Physical Development

This term our focus in PE is dance. We will continue our Funky Fingers work helping us to build our fine motor muscles for writing.

We will be thinking about how to look after ourselves and keep healthy to advise our new alien friend on healthy food and exercise.

Understanding the World

For our topic we will be finding out about astronauts such as Tim Peake and Neil Armstrong and their achievements. We will also be learning lots about the different planets, what the moon is like and parts of a rocket. We will be introducing our alien friend to Earth and making observations/comparisons of our outside environment with the alien's planet. We will be demonstrating our knowledge of technology and learning how to use iPads and computers for a range of reasons.



Exploring Art and Design

The children will be combining media to create different effects and exploring how colours can be made/ changed. We will think carefully about how to use tools and techniques in order to complete a project. This term we will be designing and making different creative projects linked to our topic such as making an alien sock puppet, junk modelling, rocket making and making an alien music piece. We will be thinking about the creations we have made; what we like and what we would like to make better next time.

Maths

We will be learning about different 2D & 3D shapes. We will use mathematical language to describe shapes and their properties. During our shape investigations we will discover how to make patterns and pictures with them.

We will be counting to 20 and using our number knowledge to make number sentences and using the vocabulary involved in adding and subtracting. We will be solving mathematical problems.

Literacy

The children have been brilliant at learning their set 1 sounds and we will begin learning set 2. This can be confusing so lots of home support is needed. (refer to Tapestry for our new sounds each week.) In Talk4Writing we will be learning How to Catch a Star and making adaptations to form our own story. We are going to be accessing lots of books linked to our topic and finding out new information about astronauts, planets and rockets. The children are going to be working on being an independent writer and knowing what resources will help if they get stuck.
