Our specialist teams are based in six localities, Chesil (Weymouth and Portland), Dorchester, East Dorset, North Dorset, Purbeck and West Dorset, Contact details are here

Our Locality teams include:

Portage Consultants – who visit homes and early years (aged 0-5) settings to support learning through play.

Family Workers – work with families and support them through challenges and difficulties.

Specialist Teachers – advise schools and help them meet the needs of our children and young people.

Educational Psychologists – work with families, schools and other agencies to meet the needs of children and young people.

SEND Provision Leads – they carry out Education, Health and Care Plan (EHC) needs assessments. They work with families to make sure that children and young people with an EHC Plan have the right support and provision in place.

Education Challenge Leads – help schools develop, improve and meet needs inclusively.
