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Dear Year 3 Parents

I hope you are all well.

Welcome to Week 7 of activities which continues to have a World War 2 focus, this week it is through the use of the Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe story. Please do as many as you can.

Thank you for continuing to get the children to 'hand in' their work. It is lovely to see what is being done at home.

The activities for this week are:

1. Continue to practice your spellings from the lists given. Remember you can always use word pyramids to help you with your practicing! Also remember to have a go at the purple mash game.
2. Maths - this week there continues to be White Rose activities and videos to complete. We continue to have a look at fractions. Remember you can always use items around the house to help the children with fractions e.g. cakes and pizzas.

White Rose:

Lesson 1 - week 1 lesson 4 - count in tenths.

Lesson 2 - week 1 lesson 5 - tenths as decimals

Lesson 3 - week 2 - lesson 1 - fractions on a numberline

3. PE this week continues to be a combination of Joe Wicks and Cosmic Yoga.

4. RE - research Pentecost and what it means. Then use Purple Mash to write up what you have found.



5. Reading continues to be using education city games - there is a folder under homework called - reading. The children can choose an activity they like the look of and complete it. There is also A World War 2 story for the children to read and answer questions about.

6. English - activities this week relate to the story the Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe. I have videoed myself reading parts of the story the children will need to:

- a. watch the first part of the story and then move onto the first activity - Lucy's Wardrobe where they will need to write a description and draw a picture of what she saw, felt, heard, smelt.
- b. Next, they will have to watch the second part and create a character profile on a character of choice - either Lucy, Edmund, Susan or Peter. They will need to consider the qualities of their chosen character – are they kind, adventurous, mischievous?
- c. Finally, they will watch the final part of the story and complete a book review for the story.
