Welcome back and welcome to Year 4. This year is a very important year for your children as they prepare themselves for Middle School next year. The expectation of the children with regard to independence, organisation and attitude will be very high this year to give them the mental strength and confidence to take on the challenges of Year 5.



We have already begun our topic on India and in Literacy we are well into the Jamila Gavin story 'Grandpa Chatterji'. We have started looking at character descriptions and are honing our knowledge of the possessive apostrophe.



In maths we are looking at number this half term. This includes place value, rounding numbers, addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. Once a week the children will have a problem solving lesson where they have to investigate, explain and give reasons for their choice of mathematical thinking.

Homework, spellings and Times tables will be given out each Friday. All homework is to be handed in each Thursday. Spellings and tables *must be practised daily;* weekly tests/dictations will happen every Friday. Please help your child get into the routine of daily revision and help them prepare for the weekly tests and dictations. We will also have mental maths tests frequently across the term.

This year, we have set up a reading reward system in class. So can I please encourage you to read with your child as often as you can and please sign their reading contact book. Through Guided Reading sessions every day, I listen to every child read over the course of a week. Please do get in touch with me if you have worries regarding your child's reading or need any ideas to help them read at home.

Our PE days are Tuesdays and Fridays.

Your children are full of possibility and potential. They have their own key to open up their personal achievement and learning. I am privileged at present, to be their door keeper and will continue to do my best for them in their learning.
