## Junk Samba Bonanza - 11.30am

### Surdo:

Anything big and hollow sounding, an upside down bucket or big plastic tub. A Floor tom-tom from a drumkit.

### Repinique:

Any small plastic tub. Smaller tom-toms from a drumkit.

Snare drum from a drumkit or a small tub with marbles in. Something with a 'buzz' sound to it or a metal cake tin.

### Tamborim:

A small handheld drum. A hard plastic picnic plate, striking the bottom. Lid of a plastic tub.

### **Agogo-bells:**

Anything metal sounding. Cowbell - strike towards the open end of the bell. Metal pots or pans.

### Ganza:

Any form of shaker. An empty Pringles tube 1/4 filled with beads or rice. A plastic water bottle with rice or similar.

A pack of tic-tacs, half empty.
