

magnetic	Objects which are attracted to a magnet are magnetic. Objects containing iron, nickel or cobalt metals are magnetic.
magnetic field	The area around a magnet where there is a magnetic force which will pull magnetic objects towards the magnet.
poles	North and south poles are found at different ends of a magnet.
repel	Repulsion is a force that pusher objects away. For example, when a north pole is placed near the north pole of another magnet, the two poles repel (push away from each other).
attract	Attraction is a force that pulls objects together. For example, when
