Thoroughly entertaining series of thrillers! A swift pace in the vein of *Jason Bourne*, with enough originality in characters and challenges to stand easily on its' own two feet.

Tied together with an over arching story line, reaching a thrilling conclusion in the final book, *Out of the Dark*. Each of the 4 main books can be read as a standalone novel, with the standard character re-caps present and story arc specific to that book.

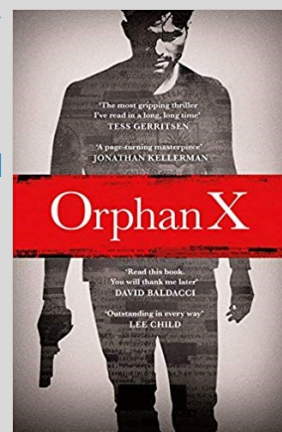
The main character is likeable, dysfunctional and dangerous. Having been secretly trained by the government as an

unstoppable assassin, only to break away, go dark and seek penance by delivering perfectly planned and usually violent vigilante justice.

Managing by the end of each book to be in an impossible situation, usually battered and broken, *Evan Smoak* still prevails, or near enough, to provide an exciting finale!

Although elements repeat, each book provides a unique series of situations and challenges to excite and thrill!
