When the caterpillars hatched they were beautiful colours. All except Sam, who's wings had no colour at all.



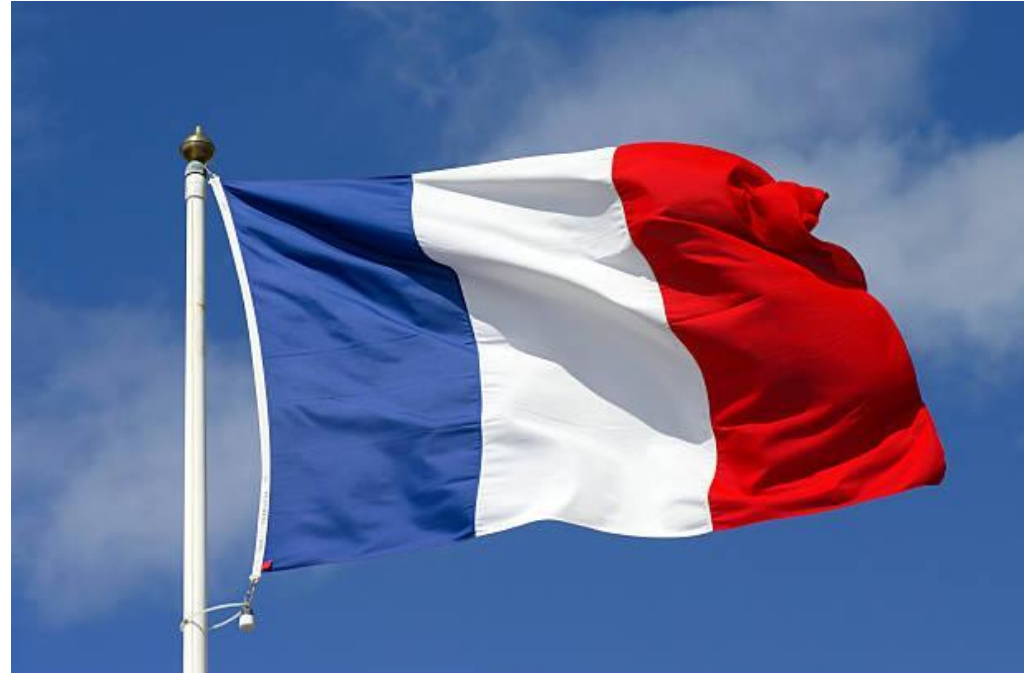
“Where are your colours Sam?” they said
