We will learn to come together, to celebrate together and to know and understand our Year 1 Gospel Value - 'kindness'. We will recognise acts of kindness by adding hearts to the branches of our Kindness Tree.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Judaism-Abraham & Moses-Integrity & Courage</u></p> <p>We will learn about Abraham and Moses and their role as leaders in the Jewish faith.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Characteristics Of Effective Learning</u></p> <p>At St Mary's we want our children to be the best they can be, we encourage a love of learning through our Characteristics:</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Go for it Gorilla: I will have a go Editing Elephant: I can edit and improve my work Creative Chameleon: I have my own ideas Concentrating Crocodile: I join in and concentrate Persevering Parrot: I keep trying Proud Peacock: I am proud of what I do</p>
<p><u>Literacy</u> In phonics sessions we will be consolidating phonics learning in reception and applying set 2 and 3 sounds in our writing. We will be having regular cursive handwriting sessions to learn how to join letters correctly starting and finishing in the right place.</p> <p><u>Here we are by Oliver Jeffers- Humility, Kindness, Compassion & Peace</u> We will start the term by responding to themes in this story. There will be opportunities to talk, share ideas and write in different forms collectively and independently. We will be building a display together as a class community to address our thoughts and feelings about being back at school together.</p> <p><u>The Three Billy Goats Gruff - Integrity, Courage, Forgiveness & Justice</u> We will be reading and retelling traditional tales. We will use Talk4Writing to recall the story of The Three Billy Goats Gruff, beginning to write the story as a narrative.</p>	<p><u>Maths</u> We will be learning to count, order reason about numbers using concrete apparatus in the class - beads, multilink, dienes & numicon. We will begin to count in ones to and beyond 10. We will learn to count forwards or backwards, finding one more, one less of a given number, finding the most and least. We will be practicing writing numbers and become secure in forming the numbers 0-9 correctly. We will be using dienes, multilink blocks and numicon to find number bonds to 10 and begin to use a ten frame to help us count. We will use + - & = maths symbols in number sentences, adding and subtracting numbers within 10 using dienes, a Singapore Bar, a part/whole frame and a number line to help us solve problems. We will start to identify number facts e.g. $1 + 5 = 6$ and $6 - 1 = 5$ and we will begin to count groups of objects.</p>	
<p><u>Science - Justice, Humility</u> We will be learning about materials and their properties. We will be identifying materials around our school and in the wider environment. We are going to link our science discoveries to the Three Little Pigs story and we shall be carrying out some experiments to see which materials are suitable for making a house for them. <p><u>Art + DT - Humility, Compassion, Kindness, Justice</u> In Art we will be using paint to create an image of the planet earth linked to 'Here we are' by Oliver Jeffers. In DT we will be designing a shoe linking to the story of 'The Elves and the Shoemaker'.</p>	<p><u>Geography</u> In Geography the children will be learning about their school environment. Finding their school on a map of the area. We will be talking about the physical features in our school environment and how we could find these on a map. We will also be learning the compass points and identify these on a map of our school.</p>	<p><u>PE - Integrity, Courage, Kindness</u> The children will learn Multi-skills: Concentrating on ABC's (Agility, balance and coordination), spatial awareness, 'sending' in different ways (rolling, bouncing and throwing) and Travelling in different ways.</p> <p><u>Music</u> We will be learning to sign to the song 'Good to be Me'. We will be identifying familiar phrases in the 'Little Pig Blues'. We will be learning the differences between pulses, rhythms and pitch, enjoying hip hop rap in its original form.</p> <p><u>ICT - Courage</u> This term we will be following the purple mash ICT scheme. This covers all aspects of the ICT curriculum for year 1 It includes simple programs, internet safety and following algorithms.</p>

<p><u>PSHE - Compassion, Forgiveness, Peace & Integrity</u></p> <p>In PSHE we will be learning about friendship and kindness. We shall introduce the kindness tree. We will be talking about how we can solve problems and take care of ourselves and each other at school and to be good friends.</p>	<p><u>History</u></p> <p><u>I</u>n History we will be learning about the history of our school, when it was built and the changes that have happened over the years. We will compare school life now to 60 years ago when St Mary's was a new school.</p>	<p><u>Forest School - Humility, Justice, Kindness</u></p> <p>In Forest School lessons we will be exploring our environment to see what is changing as we head into Autumn. We will be extending our learning about materials to see what natural materials are good for making habitats and we shall test them to see if they can stay warm and dry whatever the weather!</p>
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
