We will be thinking about what in the world we are grateful God made. We are going to learn the Sign of the Cross and have a welcome liturgy held by Father Barry.</p> <p>We will also be learning about other religions including Islam, covering some of the beliefs, customs and traditions Muslims follow.</p> <p>We will also be finding out about St Mary in addition to other Saints, special prayers and feasts.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Characteristics Of Effective Learning</u></p> <p>At St Mary's we want our children to be the best they can be, we encourage a love of learning through our Characteristics:</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Go for it Gorilla: I will have a go Editing Elephant: I can edit and improve my work Creative Chameleon: I have my own ideas Concentrating Crocodile: I join in and concentrate Persevering Parrot: I keep trying Proud Peacock: I am proud of what I do</p>	
<p><u>Personal, Social, Emotional Development</u></p> <p>Reception have made lots of positive friendships since starting school. We will be meeting an alien who has landed on a strange planet and needs a good friend. This will help us develop an awareness of aware of how others feel and how to solve problems.</p> <p>We will be trying to develop our confidence enabling us to think about what we are good at and share our ideas when facing a new activity or challenge. Linked to this, we are going to be thinking about when we need help and who may help us if we are stuck.</p>	<p><u>Communication and Language</u></p> <p>Our topic this half term gives the children a lot of opportunity to learn new vocabulary, ask questions and explain their own knowledge. The children will be undertaking a project for their home learning and will be sharing that information with their friends.</p> <p>We will also continue our Talk for Writing with some focus stories linked to our topic that the children will learn. Our first story will be How to Catch a Star. Once we have learnt the story we will then make changes to create our own!</p>	<p><u>Physical Development</u></p> <p>This term our focus in PE is dance. We shall be linking this to our topic and thinking of ways to move to the music in preparation for our dance festival. We will continue our Funky fingers work helping us to build our fine motor muscles for writing.</p> <p>We will be thinking about how to look after ourselves and keep healthy to advise our new alien friend on healthy food and exercise. Now that we are getting changed for PE on Wednesday, Mrs Coffin will also be looking to see who can dress independently.</p>	
<p><u>Understanding the World</u></p> <p>For our topic we will be finding out about astronauts such as Tim Peake and Neil Armstrong and their achievements. We will also be learning lots about the different planets, what the moon is like and parts of a rocket.</p> <p>We will be introducing our alien friend to Earth and making observations/ comparisons of our outside environment with the aliens planet.</p> <p>We will be demonstrating our knowledge of technology and learning how to use iPads and computers for a range of reasons. Such as creating space pictures using paint.</p>	<div><div><div><u>Space- What's out there?</u></div><div>Reception</div><div>Spring Term 2020</div></div><div></div></div>		<p><u>Exploring Art and Design</u></p> <p>The children will be combining media to create different effects and exploring how colours can be made/ changed. We will think carefully about how to use tools and techniques in order to complete a project.</p> <p>This term we will be designing and making different creative projects linked to our topic such as making an alien sock puppet, junk modelling rocket making and making an alien music piece.</p> <p>We will be thinking about the creations we have made; what we like and what we would like to make better next time.</p>
<p><u>Literacy</u></p> <p>The children have been brilliant at learning their set 1 sounds and we have begun learning set 2. This can be confusing so lots of home support is needed (refer to Tapestry for our new sounds each week). In Talk4Writing we will be learning How to Catch a Star and making adaptations to form our own story. We are going to be accessing lots of books linked to our topic and finding out new information about astronauts, planets and rockets.</p> <p>The children are going to be working on being an independent writer and knowing what resources will help if they get stuck.</p>		<p><u>Maths</u></p> <p>This term the children will be helping Mrs Coffin to solve lots of problems. We will be focussing heavily on doubling, counting in lots, halving and sharing (These are also tricky concepts so please support at home with the Tapestry home learning.) We will also be learning about different 2D & 3D shapes and their properties. We will be investigating shape and how to make patterns and pictures with them. We will also be looking at other aspects of shape, space and measure such as length and weight to solve problems.</p>	
<p><u>PSHE</u></p> <p>In our SCARF/SEAL groups we will be developing our ability to listen to each other, respect another person's choice or differences and to problem solve in a good way. We will be finding out about how to keep healthy and make healthy choices in addition to helping Harold the Giraffe make good choices.</p>	<p><u>PE</u></p> <p>In PE with Mr Mason we be learning a dance linked to our topic Space in preparation for our Dance festival. We will be learning to move in time to music and explore the range of ways that we can move our bodies.</p> <p>We will also be learning to use the climbing equipment safely balancing and exploring ways to move and climb.</p>	<p><u>Forest School</u></p> <p>In Forest School we will be learning about our boundaries and to respect our log circle. Once this is in place we will begin having fires and cooking outside. We will be learning about the different trees that grow on our site and how the seasons change them. We will look at how we can care for wildlife in Winter such as making bird feeders and hedgehog houses. In Forest School we also have some time to explore, climbing trees, digging in the mud and rolling down the mound.</p>
