# SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY – St Mary's Catholic First School

It is our school policy that all children wear uniform when attending school. Generic items can be worn if matching school uniform colours/styles. Generic items can be purchased at most large retailers.

The school holds some second-hand uniform items and we advertise to parents, a couple of second-hand sales during the year. If you would like to know more or require some items, please contact the school office.

Our policy:

- Promotes a sense of pride in the school
- Engenders a sense of community and belonging towards the school
- Is smart and practical
- Makes children feel equal to their peers in terms of appearance
- Is regarded as suitable wear for school and is considered by parents as good value for money
- Is designed with health and safety in mind

We ask all parents who send their children to our school to support the school uniform policy. It is the responsibility of the parents to ensure that their child has the correct uniform and that it is in good repair. Children not wearing the correct uniform will be told so by a teacher and expected to conform. Parents must support the school in such matters.

If the school is represented in the wider community it is essential that shirt and tie are worn, even in summer. The final date for summer uniform will be 1st October. Summer uniform may be worn from Easter with all in summer uniform by 1st May.

# **Reception Class**

## All year

White polo shirt Mid/dark grey trousers or shorts Mid/dark grey skirt/pinafore dress Grey socks Grey or green tights Black shoes that the child can fasten independently Sun hat Green V-neck jumper or cardigan

# Autumn and Spring Term

White polo shirt Mid/dark grey skirt/pinafore dress or trousers Green V-neck jumper or cardigan Grey socks or green or grey tights Black sensible shoes that the child can fasten independently Sun hat White shirt

## Summer Term

Green and white checked dress Mid/dark grey skirt/pinafore dress, trousers or shorts Green V-neck jumper or cardigan Grey socks Black shoes that child can fasten independently Sun hat Short-sleeved white shirt, no tie necessary

# Years One, Two, Three and Four

Green and white checked dress Mid/dark grey skirt/pinafore dress, trousers or shorts Green V-neck jumper or cardigan Grey socks Black shoes that child can fasten independently Sun hat Short-sleeved white shirt, no tie necessary

**NB** - Trainers, jeans and tracksuit trousers are not acceptable as part of the uniform. Hair ties should be green, brown or black.

It is recommended that during the summer months children are provided with a sun hat. A reversible winter jacket/coat is also available to buy from Brigade. Swimming hats, ties and water bottles are available to buy in the school office.

#### For PE (All Years)

White or black shorts, white t-shirt, plimsolls White PE t-.shirt with or without school logo

In the Autumn and Spring terms children will need a warm dark coloured tracksuit or leggings and dark coloured jumper.

# **Forest Schools Kit**

Named waterproof jacket, waterproof trousers and wellies.

(The kit to be in school every week to be used throughout the week and throughout the academic year)

# Swimming Kit

Named swimming kit will be needed in the summer term including a swimming hat. No bikinis. Earrings must be removed for swimming.

# Parents are requested to ensure that all clothing is named.

# Jewellery

Parents are requested not to send their children to school wearing jewellery. Children with pierced ears may wear studs only. The school may ask children to remove any items of jewellery which it deems to be unsafe or unsuitable.
