Dear Parent/Carer

Re: Dorset Music Service - Musicianship Programme

Your child has expressed an interest in continuing to learn a musical instrument following on from the whole class instrumental work they are currently receiving. In your child's school we are offering students the opportunity to learn to play an instrument of their choice for the next two terms, fully subsidised.

Dorset Music Service will provide your child with an instrument for the duration of the lessons and arrange for a DASP Music teacher to visit your child's Middle School to deliver group lessons to those students who have applied for a place. This work is fully subsidised by Arts Council England for two terms and includes the lessons and instrument hire. DASP Music will aim to deliver ten lessons per term (Autumn and Spring), with 20 lessons in total.

For your child to be considered for this work, you will need to complete an application form which gives consent for your child to take part in the work and forms an agreement between yourself and Dorset Music Service that you will support your child with their musical learning. This application form can be found online or alternatively you can ask your school for a hard copy.

Once we have received the application for your child, we will then share this with DASP Music who will contact you to let you know if your application for lessons has been successful and any further details regarding the lessons. Dorset Music Service will deliver an instrument to your child's school ready to use for these lessons and will collect this again at the end of the 20 programme.

The deadline to complete your application is Friday 7th June. Late applications will not be accepted.
