<p><u>Literacy</u> <u>'Here We Are' by Oliver Jeffers- Humility, Kindness, Compassion & Peace</u> We will start the term by reading 'Here We Are' by Oliver Jeffers. We will be responding to themes in this story in our writing. There will be opportunities to talk about the book and share our ideas. We will be building a display together showing our thoughts and feelings about belonging to our class, our school and the wider community.</p>		<p><u>Maths</u> <u>Sorting into groups - same/different</u> We will learn to sort objects and photographs of ourselves into groups, by finding similarities and differences. We will explore how we can sort into groups in other ways. We will be learning about the value of 10, counting forwards and backwards and finding different ways to make numbers to 10.</p>	
<p><u>Science - Justice, Humility</u> We will be learning about how we can look after ourselves and keep ourselves safe and healthy.</p> <p><u>Forest School - Humility, Justice, Kindness</u> In Forest School lessons we will be exploring our environment.
