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

Here is the Topic Web for Year 1 for the Spring Term. Our theme is 'Around the World'.





In Maths we are currently learning to count to 100 and to count in 2s, 5s and 10s. We shall be answering multiplication questions by using groups of objects and pictures. We shall also be using measurement to solve problems by comparing lengths, weight, capacity and time.

In Literacy this term we are continuing to use 'Talk for Writing' to learn, map and write



In our guided reading sessions, we will be continuing to use our phonic knowledge to sound and blend words and become more confident readers. By talking about stories, poems and non-fiction texts, we will build on our enjoyment of reading.

The structure of our morning work has changed slightly. The books are now in the cloakroom area and there will be a different class activity each morning, which the children will record in their morning books. This will help the children get ready for the day and help to consolidate what they have been learning in class.

We are hoping to start 'Forest Schools' again this term. To make this work, we really need parent volunteers to be present to help the children in our outdoor activities. It is great fun and the children really enjoy the Forest Schools experience, so if you can help, please let us know as we can't run it without you!

We would also like to ask you to continue to help your child by reading with them and to them as often as you can. Confidence in reading helps the children access all areas of learning and enjoy the wonderful experience of books.


